when the title is undefined then the Title area is suppressed.



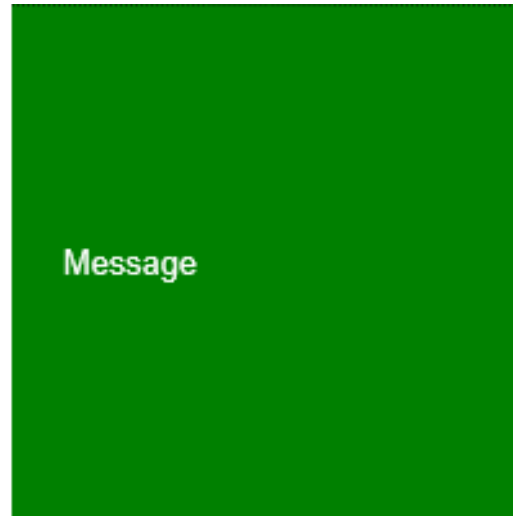
Tile Layout
