

## Enabling or Resetting Password From Green Screen

From the command line: `wrkusrprf userid` – Example: `wrkusrprf cgcowner`

Place a 2 next to the user name

```
WORK WITH USER PROFILES

Type options, press Enter.
 1=Create   2=Change   3=Copy     4=Delete   5=Display
12=Work with objects by owner

Opt  User Profile      Text
 2_  CGCOWNER          DO NOT DELETE - CGC Application User Profile
```

On the Change User Profile Screen changed the Status line from **\*disable** to **\*enabled** and press enter

The password can also be reset from this screen. Type the new password on the User Password line from **\*SAME** to the password.

To prompt the user to reset password at first login – Change the Set user password to expired **\*Yes**

Once the account is **\*enabled** or password reset – press enter

Change User Profile (CAGUSRPRF)

Type choices, press Enter.

Assistance level . . . . .	<u>*SYSVAL</u>	*SAME, *SYSVAL, *BASIC...
Current library . . . . .	<u>*CRTDFT</u>	Name, *SAME, *CRTDFT
Initial program to call . . . . .	CMQM04	Name, *SAME, *NONE
